

WINE IS MY VALENTINE



MATERIALS

DB37200 Wine Glass Detail Brush Fan Brush Pattern Pen Water Based Marker NCR Paper or Tissue Paper

COLORS

CMM 14 - Gum Drop CMM 98- Red Head CMM 5 - Coral Reef CMM 3 - Carnation CMM 31 - Licorice

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INSTRUCTIONS

- We are going to create an ombre effect blending our colors down the mug. To do this we are going to overlap the color while they're wet to create a blend.
- 2. Paint the top half of your glass with Carnation using a fan brush.
- 3. While the Carnation is still wet, use the fan brush apply Coral Reef From the middle of the handle upward toward the Carnation. Allow the colors to overlap slightly by sweeping the brush back and forth where the two colors meet to create a blended shade.
- 4. Starting at the base of the glass, use the fan brush to apply Red Head from the base to about midway up the handle. Again, allow the colors to overlap and blend.
- 5. Complete steps 2-4 again two more times.
- 6. Paint the inside of the glass with 3 coats of Gum Drop.
- 7. When the outside of the glass is dry, use either your NCR pattern or just a marker and sketch on the writing.
- 8. Finally use a detail brush to apply one heavy coat of Licorice to the words.

TIPS

- When using a detail brush, the harder you press on the brush the heavier the lines will be
- You could do this piece with different colors. Just choose 3 shades of the same color to get the easiest ombre effect.

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
