

# WATERCOLOR CHICKS





## **MATERIALS**

DB38417 Tiny Tot Chirp
Medium Brush
Small Brush
Detail Brush
Yellow Sponge Quarter

## **COLORS**

CMM 18- Pumpkin Pie CMM 21 - Mango Madness CMM 19 - Banana Boat CMM 15 - Mississippi Mud CMM 46 - Sunny Side Up



#### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Paint 2 coats of paint all over the chick. For the yellow chick, use Mango Madness. For the orange chick, use Pumpkin Pie.
- 2. Use a damp sponge quarter to wipe off the excess paint, leaving it just in the crevices.
- 3. Water down the all-over color for your chick. To do this, mix 50% water with 50% paint. For the yellow chick, use Sunny Side Up. For the orange chick, use Banana Boat.
- 4. Use a medium brush to apply 1 coat of the all-over color to the body and head of the chick.
- 5. Water down Pumpkin Pie with 50% water to 50% paint. Use a small brush to apply 1 coat to the feet and the beak.
- 6. Use a detail brush to apply 1 coat of Mississippi Mud to the eye.

### TIPS

• By watering the paint down, you'll achieve a more translucent, watercolor effect. Do not worry about 3 coats, we are not going for solid colors.
